Tristaniopsis laurina 'DOW10' (b)

ADVANCED TREES



A great feature is the bark which has a striking port colour that peels back revealing a mottled cream stem.

- Gorgeous, luscious and shiny appearance topped off with coloured new growth.
- Highly suited for street planting, parks and ovals, home gardens or just as an elegant shade tree.
- Will do best in a warm moist position, but will tolerate frosts and droughts.
- Tolerates a wide range of soils, from well drained rocky soils to heavy clay loams, provided ample water is available.
- Luscious® *Tristaniopsis* will grow 7 to 12 metres tall and will grow in full sun to part shade.
- Its larger leaf size makes it a great native alternative to *Magnolia*.

Note: Species is suitable for pruning under power lines - GRC

Density	1 plant per 2–6 m ² 1 per 3–5 linear metres
Height & Width	7–12m x 5m
Flowering	Flowers are yellow with sweet perfume from November–December
Best Planting Time	March–October
Uses	Street planting, parks & ovals, home gardens
Position	Full sun to part shade Tolerates frost & drought
Soil Type	Tolerates a wide range of soils
Care	Best in warm moist position; see website for pruning
